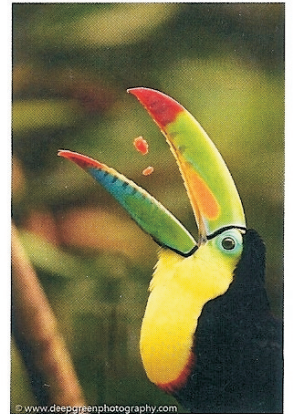


COSTA RICA TROPICAL PHOTOGRAPHY TOUR

January 15-27, 2011

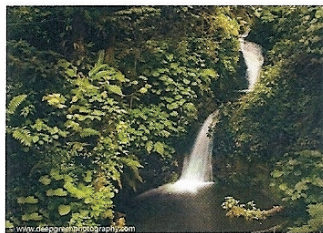
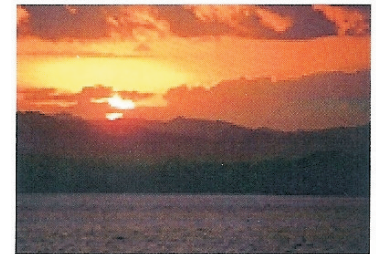
Professional photographer, Peter Boonisar, and Cabo Blanco Enterprises, specialists in travel to Costa Rica, offer you a very special and unique instructional photo safari of tropical Costa Rica.

Photograph the lush vegetation and waterways of the Caribbean lowlands encountering a wide variety of tropical flowers and animals such as monkeys, caimans and sloths that inhabit the jungle canals. View an active volcano and the rainforest canopy rich with orchids and bromeliads from an aerial tram. Learn to photograph in a closed misty cloud forest canopy in the Central Highlands. Take close up shots of butterflies, colorful frogs, tropical birds and blossoms such as orchids, heliconias, and gingers in many of the country's eco reserves and national parks. Experience coastal tropical sunrises and the pristine beaches of the dry tropical and humid forests of the Nicoya peninsula on the Pacific with a rich diversity of fauna such as howler and white faced capuchin monkeys, kotimundis, agoutis, and hundreds of exotic species of birds.



Tour escort and professional photographer, Peter Boonisar, will offer instruction throughout the tour. Peter is known for his instructional travel photography courses presented aboard Royal Caribbean Cruise Lines and Celebrity Cruises. Peter has a Bachelor of Professional Arts degree from Brooks Institute of Photography; produced the

official photographic poster for Hawaii's 25th Anniversary of Statehood; two Hawaii calendars; and was the Official photographer on the 1988 Trans-Australia Bicentennial Camel Expedition (one of only 4 people in history to walk across the continent of Australia, west to east, with camels). Peter was a Field Training Specialist with Olympus Camera Corporation and has been teaching both film and digital photography for over 29 years.



Greg Bosco, Costa Rican resident, naturalist guide, conservationist and professional photographer will provide photo tips and nature guiding services throughout the itinerary outside of the San Jose area. Greg has researched and worked in conservation in Costa Rica for 15 years. He is a full time professional photographer who shows his work through his company Deep
